



CITY OF WILTON LEAF PICKUP

Wilton Public Works crews will begin picking up leaves the first week of October. Leaves will be picked up **ONLY** at the curb. Residents are asked to rake the leaves into a pile or windrow them **BEHIND** the curb line. Do not rake leaves into the street or gutter. Leaves should be separated from other debris (NO grass clippings or tree limbs will be collected).

Leaves should be ready for pick-up by 7am on the first day of the week that your zone is scheduled for. Multiple passes will be made in your zone throughout the entire week you are scheduled for. Leaves may also be taken directly to the Convenience Center at no charge. Yard waste bags are available for purchase at City Hall for \$2 each if you wish to bag your leaves.

Any pile containing non-leaf debris **WILL NOT** be collected. If leaves are raked into the street or gutters, they can cause serious harm to the stormwater system and will not be collected.

Parked vehicles should be moved out of the way of any leaf pile so that the leaf vacuum can easily reach piles of leaves. If cars are in the way the leaves will not be collected. Do not place leaves on the corners or behind signs/mailboxes.

It is the goal of the City of Wilton to keep our streets safe and attractive. City crews will be working diligently to thoroughly vacuum all leaves that have been raked to the curb line. This is a free service that The City of Wilton is happy to offer to our residents. Every effort will be made to maintain the weekly schedule. The crews will follow the zones and special exception appointments can not be made.
